of the 8th Regiment of Minnesota Volunteer
Infantry, sent portions of his pay
to his father Nicholas Marshall, residing
in New Hampton Chickasaw Co. Iowa,
while he was in the service, that
he possessed money received for his pay
to H. Smith of New Hampton Chickasaw
County Iowa.
