

Conclusion (28 Nov 2018): From the available evidence it seems likely that George Foulke was born on 7 June 1845 in Harrison County, Ohio. The Quaker Record [6] is probably the most accurate of all and it states his birthdate as 7 June 1845. The only records stating his county of birth is an index [1] and then marriage records for one of his daughters [16], [17]. What I can say for sure is that he was born in Ohio which is confirmed by all of the US census records in which he appears. I have marked this fact as Proven.
