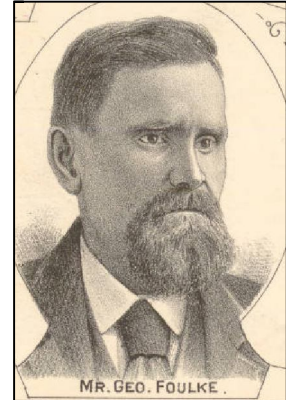

**Conclusion** (28 Nov 2018): From the available evidence it seems likely that George Foulke was born on 7 June 1845 in Harrison County, Ohio. The Quaker Record [6] is probably the most accurate of all and it states his birthdate as 7 June 1845. The only records stating his county of birth is an index [1] and then marriage records for one of his daughters [16], [17]. What I can say for sure is that he was born in Ohio which is confirmed by all of the US census records in which he appears. I have marked this fact as Proven.

On Sunday, a meeting of the American Missionary Society was held at No. 10, west of Westfield, in a grove, with 200 present. After the opening prayer by Rev. Mr. Campbell, of Noblesville, Miss Melinda Embree delivered an address on the work being done in the South and particularly for the freedmen. Rev. Mr. Atkinson, agent of the society, spoke at length. J. R. Gray, of Noblesville, spoke briefly. A collection was taken which amounted to \$140. Among those who contributed were: . . . George Foulke . . .
