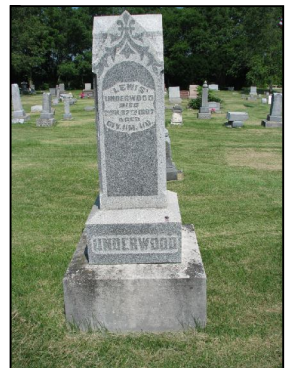

 - David Linton - There is a David Linton listed with wife Elizabeth A. - David was born in Ohio - He has 2 sons and a step-daughter in the household in Adams Township
 - No Matilda Whitson listed - No Whitson surname listed
 - Matilda M. Whitson was the wife of David Linton NOT Lewis Underwood according to the 1870 US Census
 - Does that mean the Plaintiff was actually David Linton and that he brought the suit against Lewis Underwood?
 - The newspaper article is so unclear [1]

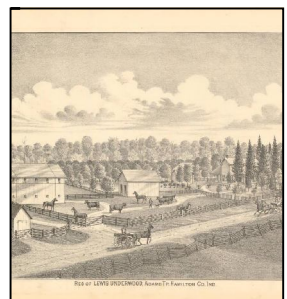
1880, Underwood Family
