****Conclusion** (6 Oct 2020): The evidence supports that the father of Narcissa Adaline Wilson was Howland Wilson and that his wife, and presumably her mother, was Ruth. Since I have evidence that Howland and Ruth were married, I have to conclude that Howland and Ruth are the parents of Narcissa.

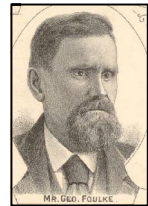
