KNOW all men by these Presents, That we Peter Heckart  
Michael Heckart, Abraham Snyder and Sebastian  
Spayd all of Mahanoy Township in the County of North  
umberland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

are held and firmly bound unto  
the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the sum of two hundred  
Pounds, to be paid to the said

Commonwealth: To the which payment well and truly to be made, we bind our-  
selves, jointly and severally, for and in the whole, our heirs, executors and administra-  
tors, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals. Dated the Seven<sup>th</sup>  
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand ~~one hundred~~ eight  
hundred

THE Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the  
above bounded Peter Heckart and Michael Heckart,

administrators of all and singular the  
goods, chattels and credits of John Heckart late of Mahanoy Township  
deceased, to make or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the  
goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, pos-  
session or knowledge of them the said Peter Heckart and Michael  
Heckart — or unto the hands and possession of any other person or persons for  
them — and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited, into the Re-  
gister's Office in the county of Northumberland, at or before the Seventh  
day of March next ensuing; and the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other  
the goods, chattels and credits, of the said deceased, at the time of his — death, which at  
any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the said Peter and  
Michael — or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for  
them — do well and truly administer according to law. And further do make, or cause  
to be made, a true and just account of your said administration, at or before the Se-  
venth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
and one, And all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits,  
which shall be found remaining upon the said administrators account (the same being first  
examined and allowed of by the Orphans Court of the said County of Northum-  
berland, shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively, as the said Orphans  
Court, by their decree or sentence, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the several  
laws now in force in this Commonwealth, shall limit and appoint. And if it shall hereafter  
appear, that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the executor  
or executors therein named do exhibit the same into the said Register's-Office, making re-  
quest to have it allowed and approved accordingly: And if then the above bounded

Peter Heckart and Michael Heckart

being thereunto required, do render and deliver the said letters of administration (approbati-  
on of such testament being first had and made in the said Register's Office) then this obliga-  
tion to be void and of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue
