

# MRS. EVA HENSEL'S WILL PROBATED

## Distribution of Property to a Number of Her Relatives

The will of Mrs. Eva J. Hensel, widow of William Hensel, was probated in the circuit court late Tuesday afternoon. Mrs. Hensel lived in the vicinity of Carmel and died a few days ago in an Indianapolis hospital following an operation. The instrument bears the date of October 25, 1925 with Marian Cornelius and Meade Vestal as witnesses.

William S. Hensel, George Hensel and Ruth Morris, step-children, are bequeathed \$250 each.

Her brother, James W. McShane, and her sister, Mrs. Alma Michener, are given \$100 each. Two other sisters, Lena Eveleth and Nona Day, are to receive \$25 each. Sarah McShane, Evalena Michener and Ruby Eveleth, nieces, will receive \$300 each.

The real estate is bequeathed to the husband during his life and at his death the property goes to the step-son, Hiram Hensel, in fee simple. All of the residue from both the real estate and the personal property is bequeathed to the husband, who is made executor of the estate under the terms of the will.
