A majority of the Committee and Trustees jointly submit the following proposition in regard to remodeling the meeting house. That the floor be raised at the east end near 18 in. with a uniform slope to the west to a point near 2/3 the length of the room with a rostrum in the west end 6x12 ft. near 16 in. with appropriate finishing, That all the windows be closed except four on each side of the house to be finished in modern style and hung with weights

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that the East door on the north side and the one in the west end be closed, and one put in the south side opposite the West door in the North side. That two new flues be built with a capacity for burning coals one on each side of the house.

That we give the new work on the outside two coats of Paint and the old work One coat. That we repaper the the room with paper similar in quality to the paper now on the walls. That the building at the south east corner be moved to the south west and a veranda over the east door and such other changes as may be thought best. And that the money for said improvements be raised by voluntary donations.

And The committee is continued to solicit funds for said repairs and report to next Meeting.

Janitors Agreement.

To care for Chester Friends Church  
The undersigned, Allie Moor, hereby agrees, in consideration of the payment of \$40.00 to him by Chester Friends Church, to serve as janitor for the above named church for a period of one year from March 11, 1914.

Payments are to be made quarterly as follows: - \$9.86  $\frac{2}{3}$  per month for

the Eleventh, Twelfth, First, Second, Third, and Fourth months and \$2.80 per month for the remaining six months.

It is agreed on the part of Allie Moon, as janitor, to open the house for all services held in it during the year at least fifteen (15) minutes before time for services to begin.

To build fires, when needed, at least fifteen (15) minutes before time for services to begin.

To give careful attention to proper ventilation during the time of services.

To sweep all floors often enough to keep them reasonably clean.

To dust all furniture, and window sills after every sweeping.

To keep all lighting fixtures clean.

To keep all walls and ceilings free from cobwebs and other unsightly substances.

To keep snow and ice from entrances in winter as well as weather conditions will admit of.

To keep weeds cut on grounds in summer season often enough to prevent obstruction in walking on grounds.

To maintain a neat appearance of the stoves by proper polishing, and to properly care for all property in any way that is necessary and not herein specified.

It is agreed on the part of Chester Friends church that all necessary brooms and dusters shall be furnished the janitor.

The janitor is to have liberty to use any competent help in

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performing the services devolving upon him.

Realizing that the time is not far distant when the Chester meeting will be discontinued on the account of loss in membership, we, the undersigned Trustees of the Chester meeting, appointed by the Westfield Monthly Meeting, hereby request the privilege and authority of selling the Chester property, including the real estate consisting of one or two acres of ground, more or less, in the northeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 north, Range 3 east, in Hamilton County, Indiana, and further request that we be granted authority to sell and convey by proper deed of conveyance the title of said property to the purchaser upon the condition and with the understanding that the amount of money received from the sale of said property be placed in the endowment fund for the Chester cemetery.

We further request that in the event the Monthly Meeting grants our request and authorizes the sale of the Chester property that this petition be forwarded to the Permanent Board of the Western Yearly Meeting at Plainfield, Indiana, for its approval.
