Blue River Quarterly Meeting held 22nd of the 7th Mo. 1826.

The Committee on the request of friends of Fairfield, made the following report in writing.

We the committee appointed to visit friends of Fairfield on their request Report we have mostly attended thereto, and are united in believing it would be right to grant their request by establishing a monthly meeting, to be held on the first ??? day in each month, and known by the name of Fairfield monthly meeting, which is untied with by this and the Women’s meeting; and the time of holding the preparative to be changed to the fifth day preceding this month by meeting. James Hadley, Eleazer Boles, and John Little are appointed to attend the opening thereof in ??? month. Extracted from this meeting by Joseph Johnson, Clk.

Fairfield monthly meeting opened and ?? 5th of the 8th mo. 1826

Agreeable to the above Extract James ???, John B. Hadley, and Eleazer Bales being present.

Abijah Pinson is appointed protempora Clerk

Joseph Hiatt, Abijah Pinson, Noah Kellum and James Horton are appointed to make choice of a clerk and report his name to next meeting. Isaac Hawkins, Richard Mendenhall, James Rhodes and Actin Ballard are appointed to make choice of two friends for Overseer, and report their names to next meeting. John Hawkins, Joseph Ballard ,and Abijah Pinson are appointed as trustees ??? and to hold a legal title to a quantity of land not exceeding five acres, including the meeting house for the use and benefit of the members of Fairfield monthly meeting, and their successors in the society forever.

. . . Robert Tomlinson is appointed Treasurer for this meeting.

The friends appointed propose John Owen for overseer which was united with and he is appointed. Also they proposed Noah Kellum for overseer which was united with and he is appointed.

Those who were appointed to propose the name of a friend for trustee to hold the right to the lot of land on which Fairfield meeting house is situated propose Caleb Summer who was united with and appointed according and Robert Tomlinson released.

Those who were appointed to prepare a certificate for Robert Tomlinson and family produced one which was approved and signed.

Mahlon Tomlinson requested a certificate in order to accomplish his marriage with Susannah Edgerton, a member of Spiceland monthly meeting of friends (Henry Co., Indiana). John Jessup and Ira Mendenhall were appointed to make the necessary inquiry and if no obstruction appears produce one to next meeting.

Date: 18 June 1840

Micajah Weasner and Jemima Elizabeth Tomlinson informed this meeting in writing that they intended marriage with each other; He not being a member of this meeting was directed to produce to our next, a certificate of his right of membership and clearness relative to marriage engagements with others.

Right Page, 16 July 1840

Micajah Weasner produced a certificate ??? from White Lick Monthly meeting of Friends dated 15th of 7th month 1840. He and Jemima Elizabeth Tomlinson appeared in this meeting and declared they continue their intention of marriage with each other; they were left at liberty to accomplish the same according to discipline. Robert Milhouse, Jr and John Jessup were appointed to attend the marriage, see if good order is observed, and produce the marriage certificate with an account of their care to next meeting.
