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Know all men by these presents that we David Bowesrd and Susannah Bowesrd wife of the same, do hereby make and declare our joint and several instrument in writing of our free and voluntary and true intent and meaning given under our hands and seals this 1st day of October A.D. 1850 That Phillipsrd trustee of the peace
County of Harrison and State of Ohio for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and one dollars and one cent paid us by the Harrison County Court House Record Oct 25th 1850 and Received Nov 12th 1850 Lancelet Keenan Recorder

County of Harrison and State of Ohio for an incorporation of the sum of four hundred and five dollars to us in kind paid by S. C. Gouverneur of the former County and State of New York for his services as Agent of the same.

O C D Jesse & Mary Souther to David Heath

Know all men by these presents that we, the said M. Heath and Mary, his wife, or their, do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant and sell and convey unto the said Solomon Crumrine his heirs and assigns forever the following premises in the County of Harrison and State of Ohio in consideration of the sum of four thousand Dollars in hand paid and held and premises by lying and being part of the land by David Heath of the County of Jefferson and State of West Virginia his heirs and assigns forever the following premises situate of Section Thirty two (32) of Township the tenth (10) in Range the first (1) in the Shadwell's District and bounded and described as follows to wit beginning at the South west corner of said quarter and running North fifty and five tenth miles in the County of Harrison and State of Ohio lying and being in Section number eleven (11) of Town to a Stake thence East thirty two and five tenth perches to a Stake thence South fifty and five tenth miles numbered eight (8) in Range number four (4) in the Shadwell's District and bounded and described to a Stake in the South line of said quarter thence west thirty two and five perches to the place described as follows to wit beginning at a Stake on the Section line where a white oak twenty inches diameter lies bearing containing ten Acres and forty nine perches to have and to hold the above bargained and sold that four links thence west thirty four chains and eighty links to a Stake on Huntington's line thence with this with the junctions and other boundaries to have the said Solomon Crumrine and to his heirs and assigns land North twelve degrees East twenty eight links to a Stake on the road leading from Cradley to Newell and the said David Powers and Susannah Powers his wife for themselves and their children the same with said road South fifty perches and a half degrees East (four pale chains) and how by covenant and agree to and with the said Solomon Crumrine his heirs and assigns that they shall look to a Stake thence South Seventeen and a half degrees East sixteen chain to a Stake thence South twenty four perches and forever defend the above premises to him the said Solomon Crumrine and to his heirs two acres and fifty nine links to the place of beginning containing sixty four Acres and seven square perches he signs against persons claiming and to claim the same and against all legal claims whatsoever the same more or less to have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said David Heath his heirs and executors and the said David Powers and Susannah Powers his wife hereinafter set the hands and signs forever. And the said Jesse M. Souther for himself and his heirs doth hereby covenant with and seals his twelfth day of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty Executed on his part David Heath his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises of the aforesaid of Henry Welch David Powers
David Powers wills that the premises are free and clear of all my other unenclosed obstructions and that he will never encroach upon them.

Know all men by these presents that we William George and Martha his wife of the County of Harrison and State of Ohio for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars paid by Miss Jane Scott of the same County and State the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell and convey to said Jane Scott the following property lying the south part of the lot number twenty-eight in the town of New Albin in the County and State aforesaid and described as follows: Beginning at the east corner of said lot number as aforesaid and running North Sixty-four feet thence west Sixty-four feet South Sixty-four feet thence East Sixty-four feet to the place of beginning with all and singular privileges and appurtenances there unto belonging or in any wise pertaining unto the same. In witness whereof we have voluntarily signed and acknowledge the same and that we are still satisfied therewith this twenty-eighth day of September in the Year of our Lord 1856 William Buchanan Justice of the peace
