 and granting Letters of Administration, in and for the County
 of *Chester* in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the
 Sum of *five Hundred* Pounds, to be paid to the said
Thomas Taylor his certain Attorney,
 Executors, Administrators or Assigns: To the which Payment
 well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally
 for and in the Whole, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators,
 firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals: Dated the
Twenty first Day of *October* in the Year of
 our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy *Eight*

THE Condition of this Obligation is such,
 That if the above bounden *Joseph Baker, Nehemiah*
Baker Administrators

of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of *Anna Baker*
 deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and
 singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which have or
 shall come to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of *them* the said *Joseph*
Baker, Nehemiah Baker

or unto the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for *them* and
 the same to do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, in the Register's Office,
 in the County of *Chester* at or before the *21st* Day of
October 1778, and the Goods, Chattels and Credits, and all
 other the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased at the Time of *her*
 Death, which at any Time after shall come to the Hands or Possession of the said
Joseph Baker and Nehemiah Baker

or into the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for *them* do well
 and truly administer according to Law. And further, do make, or cause to be made,
 a true and just Account of *their* said Administration, at or before the *21st*
 Day of *October* 1778. And all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels
