well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally
for and in the Whole, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators,
firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals: Dated the

Twenty first Day of *October* in the Year of
our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy *Eight*

THE Condition of this Obligation is such,
That if the above bounden *Joseph Baker, Nehemiah*

Baker Administrators
of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of *Anna Baker*
deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and
singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which have or
shall come to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of *them* the said *Joseph*
Baker, Nehemiah Baker

or unto the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for *them* and
the same to do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, in the Register's Office,
in the County of *Chester* at or before the *21st* Day of
November 1778, and to the said Court, and Creditors, and all
other the said Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased at the Time of *his*
Death, which at any Time after shall come to the Hands or Possession of the said
Joseph Baker and Nehemiah Baker

or into the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for *them* do well
and truly administer according to Law. And further, do make, or cause to be made,
a true and just Account of *their* said Administration, at or before the *21st*
Day of *October* 1779. And all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels
and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrators Account
(the same being first examined and allowed of by the Orphans Court of the County
of *Chester*) shall deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons
respectively as the said Orphans Court by their Decree or Sentence, pursuant to
the true Intent and Meaning of the several Laws now in Force in this Common-

and Testament was made by the said Deceased, and the Executor or Executors
therein named do exhibit the same into the said Register's Office, making Request
