Amasa Baker, born 1-7-1781 in pennsylvania and died in Hamilton county, Indiana 8-2-1874. Amasa married Sarah Hayburn 4-12-1820. Sarah Hayburn Baker died in Hamilton County. They with his father, brothers and sisters moved from near Philadelphia, Pa. to Highland County, Ohio about the year of 1826 where they resided a number of years. Later they moved to Hamilton County, Indiana. He was a tanner, shoe maker and farmer by trade. The bodies of Amasa and Sarah were laid to rest in the Baker cemetary at Baker Corner.
