Joshua F. Piles who was ENROLLED on the 5th day of Sept., 1861, in company C of the 44th regiment of Ohio Vol. commanded by W. W. Woodward and was honorably DISCHARGED at

Clarkeburg W. Va on the 30th day of July, 1865; That his personal description is as follows: Age 42 years; height 5 feet 8 inches; complexion Fair

hair, Black; eyes Black. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Charleston in the State of Virginia

on or about the 17th day of November, 1861, he contracted a severe cold which settled on his Lungs & he Here state name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.

has been affected with disease of Lungs ever since. Also about the same time & place he contract-
ed a disease of the Bowels which terminated in
Chronic Diarrhea, from which he has never
recovered causing him to be disabled from
performing but little labor.
