Josiah Tomlinson - no DOB - DOD between 12 mo 15th, 1760 and 2nd mo, 18th 1761, the dates of the writing and proving of his will - married Olive Russell [Unthank?], daughter of Samuel Russell - "The earliest record of Josiah Tomlinson in America is the precept for a land grant in South Carolina which he received from Gov George Hunter of South Carolina on Oct 25, 1751. A tract of land of 450 acres was surveyed for him on Mar 11, 1752. The tract was located in Fredericksburg Twp, Craven Co, South Carolina, (now Kershaw Co.) on the north side of the wateree River. Josiah Tomlinson was a friend of Quaker. He may be the same Josiah Tomlinson who received a removal certificate from the Friends Monthly Meeting in Dublin, Ireland on the 8th of 2nd month 1751. There was a Josiah Tomlinson living near either Timahoe or Fdenderry, County Kildare, Ireland before 1751. Timahoe was within the bounds of Dublin Monthly Meeting. Sara R Haworth, in her book Springfield, 1773-1940, claims that Josiah Tomlinson arrived on the ship Hitchcock from Whitehaven, England."
