This is the information I have on Anna and her husband. It is taken from their death certificates.

Anna Deliah born Oct. 12, 1870 in Elmira, Williams County, Ohio. ( Her mother had two sisters named Ann and Deliah). She died Oct. 1, 1942 in Bryan, Ohio. Died at Cameron Hospital of a coronary thrombosis. Henry Haas was born Mar 4, 1866 in Germany. Died April 15, 1935 in Bryan, Williams County. He too is buried at Fountain Grove Cemetery in Bryan. He had carcinoma of the stomach and liver. I looked in FAG and their memorials are not entered, so you may want to do so. Fountain Grove is a huge cemetery. Mt. Zion is a small cemetery carved out of a corn field on the main road. Started in the late 1800's, so it is well kept and the stones have not been vandalized.

Also to note, if the Williams County marriage records, Caroline Whetstone and Henry Hause. I am sure you have seen it spelled that way before.

On to my family line. Andrew and Catherine are my GG Grandparents. Andrew J. Schlosser was born Jan 16, 1830 in PA and died Feb 27, 1893 in Williams County. Catherine Guilinger (you will see it spelled several different ways) was born Nov 10, 1835 in Mercer County, PA and died June 6, 1907 in Williams County. They are buried in Buck Creek Cemetery. It is a remote cemetery and many of the stones there have been vandalized. They had ten children. Three died as infants or toddlers. Two of the boys married the Whetstone sisters, and my great grandmother was the youngest.

I am more than happy to help. I do not live in Ohio anymore, but do have many of the Williams County and Defiance County record books if you need a look up. I don't have them all, but am glad to see if I do.
