WATER FACILITIES

ATEX TACILITIES

Direct pressure system of water works owned by the city. Installed in 1898. Two reservoirs at pumping station, combined cap'y 335,000 galls supplied from nine 8" wells, Two Gordon compound duplex pumps (10×16×10×18) cap'y one million galls each per 24 hours.

15 miles of water pipes 4" to 10" diam. 112 double hydrants. Domestic pressure 60 lbs. Fire pressure 100 lbs. Average daily consumption 425,000 galls.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Two paid men. 14 volunteers, paid on call. 2500 fc. 2½ cotton rubber lined hose. One Diamond combination hose and chemical auto. truck 4 cyl. 40 gall. chemical tank, 200 fc. 1" rubber hose, Two 3 gall. chemil exting rs, 40 ft of ladders. One hand drawn ladder wagon with 50 fc. extension ladder, one each, 20 fc. 18 fc. and 14 fc. ladder. One Ford auto. truck in reserve.

Fire alarm by telephone and whistle at pumping station.


